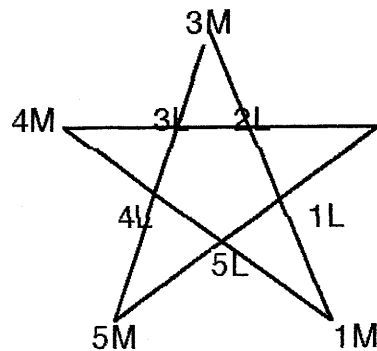


ASCENDING STAR OF ABINGWORTH

Great star set (i.e. 10 people) arranged with ladies inside facing partner outside in a star shape



5 x 40 jigs

Part 1

A1,2 All circle right half way, men outside and ladies back ring, set and turn single. Repeat back.

Part 2

A1,2 All forward a double round star clockwise with partner and fall back, set and turn single. Repeat anticlockwise.

Part 3

A1,2 Side into line, set and turn single

Part 4

A1,2 Arm, set and turn single.

Part 5

A1,2 Half two hand turn and poussette out with partner (men push) set and turn single. Repeat back.

Parts 1-5

B1&2 Progressive pentagram: Men advance straight forward along line of star to place of lady two places beyond to left, e.g. 1st man to 4th lady's place (clockwise) while ladies move forward to partners' places, then men move on to new point beyond while ladies follow to place where partner was. Repeat 3 more times to new places.

C Right hand turn with partner, step and honour
